2024 HBCU Academic Scholarship Guidelines

Application Deadline Extended: March 22, 2024

The ladies of the **Mu Omega Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc.** in partnership with the Ivy Community Fund, Inc. are proud to announce our HBCU scholarship. A one-time first place scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded to a student graduating from high school. The award is for academic use. All recipients must meet specific academic requirements and must plan to attend an HBCU in the fall of 2024.

Please read all instructions carefully before you begin to submit documents. All documents submitted become the property of the Mu Omega Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. It is the responsibility of the applicant to submit a complete application packet. Only completed applications will be reviewed and considered.

Eligibility

The Mu Omega Omega HBCU award is available to an African American student who is a Colorado resident graduating from high school.

- The student must possess a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- The student must plan to attend an HBCU 4-year College/University beginning the fall semester of 2024.
- This is a one-time award - A graduating high school senior may only apply to one Mu Omega Omega Scholarship Award.

Scholarship Information

The 2024 Mu Omega Omega HBCU Academic Scholarship is a one-time award in the amount of \$1,000. Funds will be disbursed to the student's HBCU - in the name of the recipient - once the verification of enrollment letter from the college/university's registrar is received.

Documentation Requirements

Submit the complete application electronically, as well as the following:

- Two letters of recommendation (teacher/counselor)
- An official transcript (Mail sealed or email directly from counselor to scholarship chairman)
- Photo
- Two essays
